Cuts have already been made and impacted the quality of our schools:

- Over \$3 million in cuts have been made by the school district in the last 18 months
- Reduced the amount spent on instructional materials including textbooks and computers
- Eliminated approximately 25% of Central Office staff and 18% of teachers and other support positions
- Reduction in Federal and State funds have shifted a heavy burden to our students and our schools
- Students are required to pay some costs to participate in sports, clubs and other school activities
